

# PICPOUL DE PINET

## OUSTRIC

**P**icpoul de Pinet is the largest white wine producing area in the Languedoc, stretching along the Thau lagoon to the west of the Mediterranean Golfe de Lyon. The terroir consists of a triangle bounded by Agde, Pézenas and Sète. The weather pattern is typically Mediterranean with low rainfall and moderate winters. Summers are dry and sea breezes reduce high daytime temperatures. The lagoon protects the land from night-time temperature falls. The Picpoul grape inclines to ripen late, and the warm and humid sea breezes bring perfect conditions for an optimum maturation.
